# About our riverboats

## Electric Riverboat

The electric riverboat is perfect for families who want to spend a morning or afternoon on the Thames. The boat is covered with a fixed roof so your day won't be spoilt if it rains.

We'll provide a map, all the safety equipment and instructions you need to operate the boat. If you travel for more than an hour, you may need to navigate through locks and we'll explain how to do so safely

## Antaris Sixty6 Launch

The Antaris launch is diesel-powered and is perfect for a full day on the river. The boat features a fully collapsible roof for when it is sunny and there are drinks coolers to keep your favourite tipples cool. The boat is fitted with a Bluetooth stereo which you can connect your device to, to play your own music as you cruise along the Thames. The launch also has plenty of storage cabins so you can stow your belongings.

## Terms and conditions

Any loss or damage to the boats is the hirer's responsibility; a valid credit card with funds of up to £250 must be available upon arrival so that a security deposit can be taken.

The electric riverboat has a battery life of five hours; when hired for eight hours this must include three hours of mooring.

Hire of any of our boats is entirely at your own risk.

Health and safety documents will be provided which will need to be read and signed before the commencement of hire.

Day hire runs from 10.30am to 6.30pm.

Prices include VAT at the standard rate and lock tolls.

Payment for the period of hire must also be made before the commencement of hire.

We reserve the right to re-let the riverboat if it is not collected within one hour of the time booked.

The first hour's rental fee is payable on booking as a non-refundable deposit which is redeemed against the total of the boat hire.

The hirer must be over the age of 21 and proof of age is required.

Hire of our riverboats is strictly subject to river conditions.
